



The Mount Pleasant Rotary Club sponsors the annual Christmas Parade for the city. The Rotary Club has been putting on the parade since 2000. The parade has averaged over 100 entries each year. There are floats designed by local businesses, civic groups and schools, marching bands and the Mount Pleasant High School Tiger Dolls. Also, Santa Claus always present to complete the parade. The parade is normally on the first Saturday in December. The route normally starts from the Titus County Civic Center and proceeds to the downtown square.
