



Population & Size	- 35,918,915 - 241,038 sq. km.- (20% water mass)	Oregon -3.8m (2011) 254,810 sq. km.
Age Structure	Younger 24 years: 69.9%, 42.9 % 14 and under	
Birth Rate/Pop Growth	44.17 births/1,000 population (2014 est.) 3.24% (2014 est.)	3/9
Mother mean age at first birth	Mother's mean age at first birth: 18.9 note: median age at first birth among women 25-29 (2011 est.)	
Urbanization/Rural	Urban population: 15.6% of total population (2011)
