PolioPlus. Since 1985, Rotary members have helped immunize more than 2.5 billion children against polio. As of June 2016, Rotary had committed more than \$1.6 billion to global polio eradication, seeking to eliminate it in the last three countries where it remains endemic and to ensure that it does not return elsewhere. In 2015-16, program awards, including PolioPlus Partners grants, totaled \$114.7 million.

Rotary Peace Centers. Each year, the Foundation supports studies by peace fellows at six Rotary Peace Centers, where they earn master's degrees or professional development certificates. Since 2002-03, 1,058 fellows from more than 120 countries have participated. In 2015-16, 89 fellows from 39 countries studied at Rotary Peace Centers, and program awards for the fellows and centers totaled \$4.1 million.


District grants. District grants support smallerscale, short-term projects related to the Foundation's mission. In 2015-16, the Foundation approved 494 district grants, and program awards totaled \$25.5 million.

Global grants. Global grants fund large-scale international activities with sustainable, measurable results that support Rotary's areas of focus. Activities include humanitarian projects, scholarships, and vocational training teams. In 2015-16, the Foundation approved 1,165 global grants, and program awards totaled \$70.0 million.
