NEW WELLESLEY ROTARY PROJECT!

Did you know that approximately one third to one half of the 4,629 students enrolled at MassBay Community College come to school on an empty stomach? This is includes 2,950 women and many veterans.

Wellesley Rotary has applied for a District 7910 District Grant for the 2019-2020 year under the goal of "basic education and literacy". It seeks funding to launch a Lunch Program to assist approximately 300 students, generating about 10,000 meals over a selected period of time. The pilot plan will involve 8 Wellesley Rotarians to serve on a Committee, totaling about 180 volunteer hours. Non-Rotarians will be included in the implementation. Although Wellesley Rotary is the sponsoring club, other Rotary clubs will be invited to participate. If successful it is hoped the program will expand to other community colleges in the system. This is an opportunity for other Rotary clubs to join and expand their service to other community colleges in the area. Cost of the program is estimated to be \$5,000 including support from the District Grant.
