

and is thus able to walk to school. Last year he was studying in Florida at a golf school. Next year, he will be attending Stanford where other famous golfers such as **Tiger Woods** attended. Next, **Dr. Melani Nerambali** and her son, Rohan, presented a power point program regarding efforts to build a Community Center in the Indian state of Karnataka. This is the same area where **Bob Anthony** delivered the Adolescent Wellness Program to the Siddi people last year pursuant to the grant received from Rotary International. Melani described the need to purchase property for the center and the issues involved siting the facility so that it will be convenient for the Siddi people to attend where travel is a problem in that part of India. Although funds have been raised for the center, more will be needed to complete the project. The meeting concluded at 8:00 pm.
