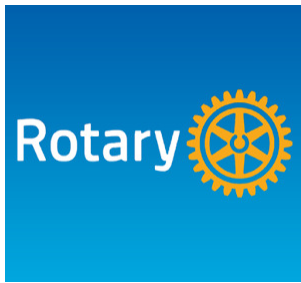
TASTE OF WELLESLEY... a Great Success!

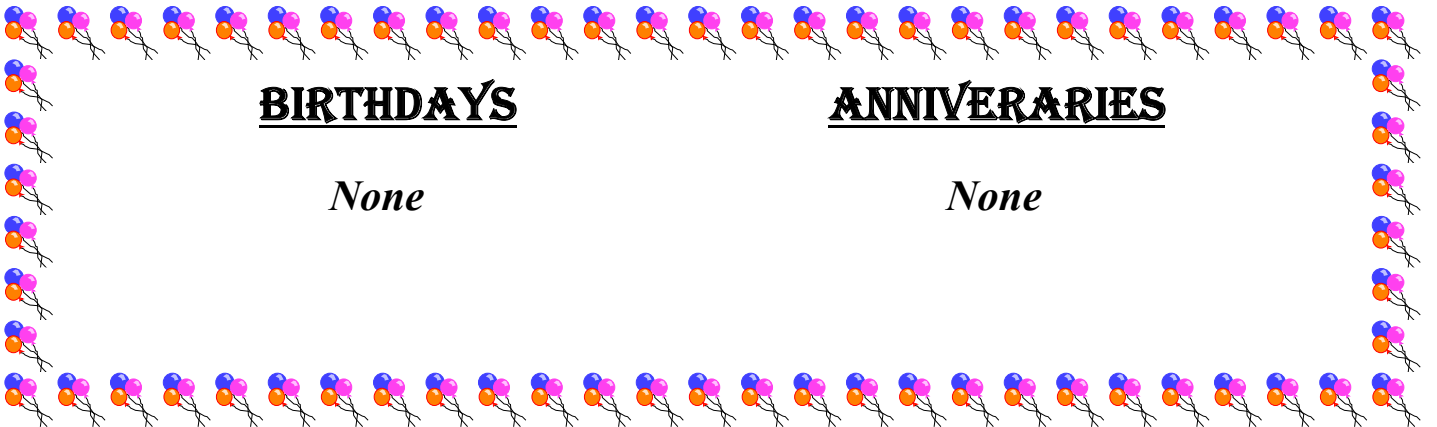
