Prez Scott reminded Rotarians we are moving our meeting site to the Wellesley College Club commencing with the April 4th meeting (see information on p. 1). He then introduced our guest speaker, Carl Foster. Carl gave un a very insightful way to improve our speaking skills. Objectives: We have the potential to be better speakers. How? By changing our method, strategy and reaching for a different commitment. Efficient use of time should be directed to content (what—writing skills) and delivery (how—apply speaking). He explained the two skill-sets of speaking: conversational (interactive) and, public speaking (non-interactive). 40% of one's time should be spent in preparing (memorizing the content) and 60% on delivery (the problem!). Not enough time is spent in practicing one's speech. The extraordinary difference is to "memorize" (to focus and inspire) and then "repeat" it (to persuade). How do you get good fast? Carl suggested the "champion way": speak often (it helps in delivery); practice out loud; develop tone, tempo and pauses; get a group evaluation and join Toastmasters! He encouraged us to become extraordinary! Many interesting questions followed.
