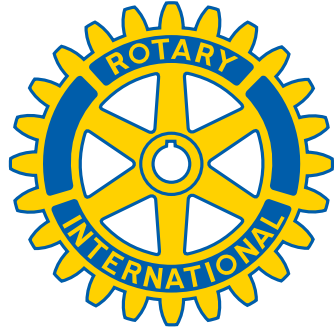

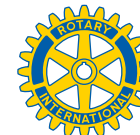

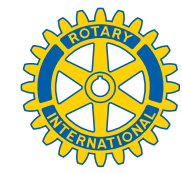

Today is a beautiful Wednesday for a Rotary meeting, so we're having one!
It is our honor to have Mike Cousineau as our guest speaker. Mike and his wife, Deleen, have living a working in Cote d'Ivoire, West Africa, off and on for the last 37+ years.
Mike's work there focused on water, health and education to assist residents of an area decimated by war, civil disorder and poverty. Mike graduated from Hillsdale College in 1974. He has been the director and developer of THP, and international humanitarian organization, as well as the co-founder and director of the Leadership Training Institute, Bouna, Cote d'Ivoire, West Africa. Mike served also as the Business Administrator for the International School, Bouake, Cote d'Ivoire, and has also established the 1040i Initiative, a non-profit based in Norman, OK,, to assist this struggling country. Mike also works to provide safe drinking water to the people of the Middle and High Atlas mountains in Morocco.
