For the last ten years she has taught women in rural Uganda about safe water, how to avoid and prevent malaria and the importance of delivering their babies in a clean environment. Her annual trips include immunizing babies, encouraging students to stay in school and meeting with elected officials to help improve the lives of thousands living in poverty without running water or electricity. BARHD is a non-profit focusing on health, education and development in rural Uganda.
