Rotary Serving Humanity

JULY 20, 2016

Our program today is a video by the Rev. Dr. Mouzon Biggs, Jr. discussing the theme for this year, "Rotary Serving Humanity." RI President John F. Germ chose this theme which emphasizes Rotary's unique ability to bring together committed professionals to achieve remarkable goals. Dr. Biggs has been the Senior Minister at Boston Avenue Methodist Church in Tulsa, OK since September 1980. He was educated at Centenary College in Louisiana and Perkins School of Theology where he earned the Master of Theology degree in 1965. Dr. Biggs also was awarded a Doctor of Divinity from Texas Wesleyan University and a Doctor of Humane Letters from Oklahoma City University. Many other awards have been bestowed upon Dr. Biggs for his work in interfaith and interracial areas. He is also past president of the Oklahoma Center for Community and Justice and past president of Tulsa's Downtown Rotary Club.
