

Official Rules - District Music Contest - Virtual or in Person depending upon pandemic and Dept. of Public Health Guidelines March 19, 2022

- 1. Contestant must be currently enrolled in high school or home schooled, and of high school age.
- 2. District Music Contest Cash Prizes for each section of the competition:

1st Place - \$1,000.00 2nd Place - \$500.00 3rd Place - \$250.00

- 3. Contestant may be selected by a Sponsoring Rotary Club or have won 1st place at a Sponsoring Rotary Club music contest prior to Feb. 28, 2022. Only 1 contestant for Vocal and 1 for Instrumental may be sent to the District Music Contest per Rotary Club.
- 4.. The district finals will be held March 19 in Glendale, CA. Location will be announced prior. If covid restrictions still occur, a virtual platform will take place with the Zoom link and password provided to registered participants, who may invite family, friends, and teachers.
- 5. Due to uncertain times, currently a live district competition will take place on March 19 but may pivot to virtual due to pandemic restrictions. Whether in person of virtual, all performances must be live. Vocals may not be enhanced via pitch correction or pre-recording. The only pre-recording allowed is instrumental background accompaniment music.
- 6.Contestants are responsible for providing their own instruments, accompanist or instrumental recording if used as background music for performance. If contestants run into complications, please contact Sharon Townsend at shar.townsend@gmail.com for assistance.
- 7. Maximum performance time is 6 minutes. Please try to adhere to the time limit as performances will be cut at 6 minutes though it will not affect overall judging. Judging Rubric is used in evaluating contestants and will be available on the District Rotary website prior to the competition.
- 8. The First Place Winner(s) will be expected to perform at the District Conference. The conference may be held in person at or virtually. TBD. Please contact Sharon Townsend for further instructions. Shar.townsend@gmail.com
