Rotary Principles

Business and professional persons representing a myriad of vocations make up the membership and they are committed to the ideal of "Service Above Self." Littleton Rotary and its members have been active in major community projects in metro Littleton since 1922.

Object of Rotary

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster: **FIRST**, The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service. **SECOND**, High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society. **THIRD**, The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life. **FOURTH**, The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

"The Four-Way Test"

Followed by Rotarians worldwide in their business and professional lives, it has been translated into more than 100 languages, and is used by organizations and individuals throughout the world. The Four-Way Test of things we think, say, or do: 1) Is it the TRUTH? 2) Is it FAIR to all concerned? 3) Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS? 4) Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Rotary Service

Littleton Rotary Club provides you with avenues to "give back to your community and world" relevant to your interests and capabilities in time, talent or treasury while expanding your metro Littleton fellowship. Members are given a classification based on your profession and interests to assist in professional growth, faster assimilation into Littleton Rotary and professional diversity.
