Rotary Principles

Rotarians are committed to the ideal of "Service Above Self." Littleton Rotary and its members have been active in major community projects in metro Littleton since 1922.

Object of Rotary

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster: **FIRST**, The development of acquaintances as an opportunity for service. **SECOND**, High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society. **THIRD**, The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life. **FOURTH**, The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

Considering the motto of Rotary, “Service Above Self,” please describe briefly how you envision your experiences and skills being applied to your membership in Rotary:

The Littleton Rotary Young Leader program offers all the benefits of becoming a Rotarian and a leader in your community, but at a significant discount. A 60% discount is offered to anyone thirty-nine years or younger who wants to make a difference in their community.

Semi-annual dues (normally \$250) will be reduced to \$100. To maintain the maximum discount, you must achieve a 50% or greater participation level based on your previous six months of service. This can easily be achieved by averaging just two or more Rotary Events per month.

Qualifying events include:

- Club Meetings
- Club Projects (volunteer work)
- Club Committee Meetings
- Club Social Events
- Club Related Functions (community meetings or other functions related to Rotary)

Based on my previous 6-month participation level, I agree to pay the current reduced semi-annual dues of:

\$180.00	9 or more events attended
\$250.00	8 or less events attended

Dues are invoiced semi-annually and pro-rated from date of induction and payable on Invoice (when invoice is received) in accordance with the bylaws of the Club. I understand that a \$25 Admission Fee Must be included with this application and if I am accepted into membership, this Fee will be non-refundable.

I understand that it will be my duty to exemplify the Object of Rotary in all my daily contacts and activities and to abide by the constitutional documents of Rotary international and the Club.
