



Grant Request Guidelines

The Littleton Rotary Foundation's (LRF) mission is to support 4-areas of focus 1-feeding the hungry 2-helping those in poverty 3-supporting education and 4- community services.

Evaluating Littleton Rotary Foundation Projects

Preference will be given to projects, activities, or organizations which exist in, or have a direct association with, the greater Littleton area based on need and compatibility with Rotary principles.

Preference will be given to projects, activities, or organizations recommended by the Littleton Rotary Club Board of Directors, especially when such funding is in support of a club project.

Preference will be given to projects, activities, or organizations which are named by Littleton Rotarians who are actively and personally involved in the nominated project, activity, or organization.

Preference will be given to requests that support underprivileged persons or humanitarian projects.

The award of a grant must provide benefit to the community, and the Rotary Club of Littleton should receive some public recognition of its financial support.

If it would be helpful for Rotary to issue a Challenge Grant, let us know how this might work for you (a Challenge Grant is where Rotary would offer to match donations you receive from other sources up to a specified match from Rotary).

Grants will not exceed \$10,000 without approval of club members.

Grants will not be made to support political candidates and/or political campaigns.

TIMELINE

Requests must be submitted by April 30, 2026 for review by the Foundation Board.

The Foundation will review and approve grants in June for the fiscal year - July 1 - June 30, 2026.

Approved grants will be notified in Mid-June and funded in Mid-July.
