Mr. Orestis is paid a salary of \$19,500.

The first year of the lottery it earned \$1,200,000. The second year it more than doubled its earnings with \$2,600,000. This should prove to the skeptics that the lottery is working and that in the most part, wanted by the general public.

The mechanics of the lottery are run by a staff of 38 people. From its inception, the lottery had been burdened with last minute pull out by the bank in distribution of the tickets, its restrictions in advertising the game, and the federal law prohibiting the use of the U.S. Postal Service.

On the lighter side of the spectrum was the human interest stories of some of the big money winners. I couldn't help thinking of the old T.V. program "The Millionaire". I now realize there was some possible truth to those stories. The lottery people do caution the winners on the woes of having so much money, and that they should seek financial advice.

Officer Richardson and the South Portland Police Department are to be commended for their efforts with the youths.

judicial courts; changes that won't necessarily cost the taxpayer more money but im-

prove the pace and efficiency of justice.

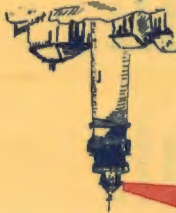
