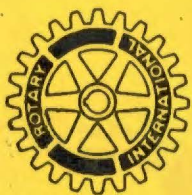

### Ask the Answer Man

What are the qualifications for active membership in Rotary?

Each active member shall be an adult of good business or professional reputation engaged as a proprietor, partner, corporate officer, or manager, of any worthy and recognized business or profession; or holding an important position in an executive capacity with discretionary authority in any worthy and recognized business or profession; or acting as the local agent or branch representative of any worthy and recognized business or profession; having entire charge of such agency or branch in an executive capacity. He/she must personally and actively be engaged in the business or profession in which he is classified in the club and must either work or live within the club's territory, or within the corporate limits of the city in which the club is located, or within the territorial limits of an adjoining club.

How may an active member lose his membership?

Active membership is terminated automatically when a member ceases to be personally and actively engaged in the classification of the business or profession under which he is classified or ceases to have his place of business or residence within the territorial limits of his club or within the corporate limits of the city in which his club is located or within the limits of an immediately adjoining club.

By severing his connections with his business establishment (even if his kind of business remains the same).

For cause or resignation.

By non-payment of dues to the club. or failure to comply with attendance

### The Program

Former Secretary of State Mark Gortley spoke to the club on his new endeavor as general manager of Cellular One. Mark noted that cellular telephones are nothing more than normal push button phones that are portable and can be used in a specific coverage area.

The concept of cellular phones has been around since the 40's but it was 1981 before the first system was put into commercial use. In four years, cellular phone users have grown from 0 to 1,000,000.

The FCC allows two companies to operate within a specific market - in Maine the PUC oversees the operation. The system costs approximately \$1,000 per automobile with monthly rates varying from \$0.25 to \$0.75 a minute.

Mark points out that this service is not for everyone but can be a useful tool to many professionals. There are three reception towers located in Gray, Portland and Brunswick. The phones have a reception area of approximately 15 miles from each tower.

## Last Week

### The Program

Nick Pappas introduced Bill LaFevre, a nationally known investment strategist with Advest, who gave a brief but informative talk on the health of the financial markets.

Bill began by stating that the "fall crash" was a "markdown in stock prices, not in the economy". In fact, he described the whole event as a "panic of professional investors" particularly "yuppies" who had bought on margin.

The institutions still have not returned to the market even after strong 4th and 1st quarters fearing a recession. Bill does not agree. Although he does not see "strong" growth over the next year he does see growth - growth with a lot of "agitation".

Interest rates will continue to move upward caused primarily by banks financing their "past mistakes" by increasing finance costs on variable rate mortgages and consumer loans. In short, price increases will not be caused by "repressed demand" but by the "need of banks" for liquidity.

What then should we invest in? Bill feels both stocks and bonds are good investments for the next few years - with the best bet being U.S. Treasury Bonds - 10 or 30 year issues.

### Distribution of Club Funds

Visiting Rotarian Jim Rowe provided the membership with a brief description of the club's financial structure. He explained that the club maintains two budgets - an external budget and an internal budget. The internal budget is funded through dues and other membership solicitations - it is used to operate the club. The external budget is funded through fund raising events in the community - all funds in the external budget are returned to the community through gifts and grants to various community programs.

A few years ago, the board adopted a policy for receiving and handling requests for money and/or help. The procedure is - requests should be made in writing to the finance committee consisting of the directors of the four avenues of service. The committee then makes a recommendation to the entire Board of Directors for final approval.

Pres Doug noted that although it is appropriate to have a recipient of funds provide a program informing the club of its endeavors, it is not appropriate to have as a program a request for funds.

## THE GOVERNOR'S VISIT

District Governor Ron Drouin, presenting a theme of Strength through diversity, gave an overview of the many things that are happening throughout the world through Rotary. His analogy likened the clubs to the trees of a forest with the total energy yielding greatness.

Governor Drouin compared three new projects of Rotary as young saplings reaching for the sky. These programs are the Rotary Village Project, Drug Abuse programs at local levels, and the Rotary Peace Forum.

Mature Rotary programs that now stand tall like solid oaks include: the 40 year old Rotary Scholarship program that has assisted 17,000 students to date with \$126 million dollars. There are currently 1400 in the program. Interact is now in 85 countries, involves 5390 clubs and 119,000 young people. And the Youth Exchange with 8600 students from 60 countries was cited. The Group Study program that was begun in 1965 results in international exchanges for 6 weeks. It will have a group from France this year.

The Governor was especially pleased to announce the continuing success of the District's Project Dominican Republic. Twelve wells have been dug, 8 more are being dug and 23 more are planned. Included in this project are free health clinics and schools that are serving 1200 people a day, 7 days a week.

Polio-Plus which will provide vaccine to help eradicate crippling diseases was also cited by Ron as well as his notice of how well our own club had done.

In District Governor Ron Drouin's words, "We can't do it alone, but as a group we can work wonders".

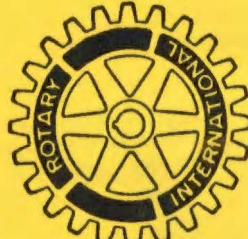

### The Program

Dick Kilroy introduced 1st District Congressman Joe Brennan who discussed what he described as America's greatest threat - the \$2,500,000,000,000 deficit. Rep. Brennan feels that Congress is unable to come to grips with spending because:

1. there is no incentive to cut existing programs even if they are unnecessary.
2. powerful (through seniority) congressman hide wasteful and ill-conceived programs in amendments to huge appropriation bills.

Contrary to the position of his own party's leadership, Mr. Brennan offers two structural changes he feels would go a long way in helping solve the deficit problem:

1. passage of a Balanced Budget Amendment.
2. enactment of a line item veto for the President.

He noted that at the state level, 49 of 50 states forbid deficits, he further noted that the only state that has not maintained a balanced budget in the last three years is the one that is not required to do so.

Mr. Brennan feels the item veto is an absolute necessity for the chief executives of both the state and Federal governments. It is a balance against the legislature's ability to tie wasteful special interest amendments to large and important appropriation bills.

### The Program

Dan Davidson introduced Gary Willette, Executive Director of the Portland YMCA, who discussed the organization's history and hopes for the future.

### What was and is the YMCA?

Mr. Willette explained that the YMCA was founded in the mid 1800's to meet the recreational and housing needs of rail and marine workers. The Portland YMCA, third oldest in the nation, was founded in 1890. The old Libby Building (located at the site of the Museum of Art) was the organization's first home and contained the state's first indoor pool. In 1921 a new building and pool were built at the Y's present location on Forest Ave. This building was then enlarged to its present size in 1968.

Today the YMCA provides services to men, women and children. 38% of its clientele are women and 62% men. In addition to providing temporary housing to 90 men, the Y offers a wide range of recreational and social services to people in the greater Portland area. Its fastest growing service is child care for infants, toddlers and adolescents.

- is a present or past officer of Rotary International.

## Last Week

### The Program

Bill Kourakos introduced Barry Valentine, Director of the Portland Jetport. Barry gave a brief history of the airport and then discussed its' progress in noise abatement.

The airport's history began in 1927 when two biplanes landed at the "Stroudwater Field" to demonstrate the "promise" of flight. Eight years later the Boston & Maine Airways initiated the first commercial flight from Portland. The first terminal building was constructed in the 30's and functioned as such until 1968. Boardings at the Jetport have increased from 62,000 in 1966 to over 610,000 in 1988. Presently, Portland is serviced by 4 major airlines and two commuter airlines. The four majors hold approximately equal shares of Portland's passenger market.

Barry feels that the noise and congestion are the biggest problems facing the airport. The noise issue is being addressed in three ways:

- pilots are being asked to utilize a Fore River approach that lessens the noise in the South Portland/Cape Elizabeth areas;
- whenever possible, planes use westerly take-off;
- officials are lobbying that residential housing be limited in the areas west of the airport;

Congestion, particularly automobile parking is the being addressed with the purchase of additional land for parking lots and terminal space.
