A twenty minute visit about Portland Pipeline's operation of unloading oil in Portland and piping it to Montreal for refining proved very informative and reinforced the pipeline's exemplary record in reducing the chances of oil spills and contamination in our environment.

It was interesting to see the series of eight pump stations set up enroute to Montreal to boost the pumping flow especially over the high terrain of 1900 feet above sea level in Vermont. It was also interesting to note the one of their lines is currently leased to bring natural gas back from Canada.

Ted Hendricks (Director of Operations at Portland Pipeline Corporation) assisted Harry with the presentation and taking questions afterwards.
