**Speaker :**

Richard introduced us to a project he participated in to create a bi-centennial walkway in and about the cliffs near Sydney. Part of the project was done in conjunction with the Rotary club of Sydney. Rotary approached Richard and asked if they could participate. Rotary of Sydney contributed \$2,000 toward a bronze relief map of the area which was mounted on a stone pedestal at one

of the scenic points along the walkway. Rotary also help to plant the Headland with plants indigenous to the area. Richard's slides of Sydney and the walkway project demonstrated the beauty of Australia's coastline and the efforts of its citizens to preserve its heritage.
