This drug is very easy to obtain on the streets. Rehabilitation is at a moderate success rate for the kids. Kids are good at helping each other in rehabilitation. We shouldn't look at the war on drugs, we should be looking at the war on dependency. Let's focus on prevention for our next generation. They're going to need it.
