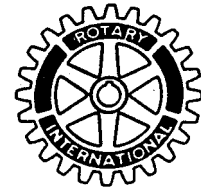

This past Wednesday, it was suggested at our meeting that our Club should assist with the many needs. A show of hands unanimously recommended to the Board that the club should make a donation.

The Board of Directors voted an immediate \$1,000 contribution to the South Miami Rotary Club. It was also voted to match member's contributions made by September 30, 1992 up to an additional \$1,000. If members contribute a total of \$1,000, we would then be sending a total donation of \$3,000. The funds will be utilized by the Rotary District in the effected areas primarily to purchase supplies for Rotary volunteers to repair homes.
