- (6) Once all of the above has been accomplished, the proposer asks the proposee if he/she would like to join and, if affirmative, the proposer shall inform the prospective member of the purposes of Rotary and of the privileges and responsibilities of membership in the club.
- (7) The Secretary signs the person up.
