One of the interesting aspects of this new master plan is restoring the saltwater marsh and providing indigenous vegetation. The group, The Friends of Millcreek Park, is actively looking for non-profits to partner in facilitating this process. The new Millcreek Park will have a much more inviting feel to it. The corner where we sell our trees will be leveled out and will provide us with space for many years to come. Thank you to Jack Roberts for inviting Regina to speak to us this evening.
