The Sector conducts over 800 searches & rescues a year and over 750 inspections of commercial vessels. They are also involved in homeland security issues and various threat responses. David showed a video of a recent rescue that gained national attention at Thunder Hole at Acadia National Park, which was dramatic because of the extremely rough weather. The Sector's motto is "All Threats, All Hazards, Always Ready." Thank you to Dan Davidson for inviting David to speak to us tonight.
