Polio Plus - The following is a statement from the International Polio Plus Committee. "Global certification: An independent commission will

consider global certification when no wild polio virus-associated cases have occurred for at least three years, in the presence of certification-standard surveillance and all wild poliomyelitis stocks have been appropriately contained."

Program - Our speaker tonight was Wayne Davis, Chairman of Train Riders Northeast, a non-profit educational corporation of over 1300 members formed in June 1989 to bring Amtrak passenger service to Portland. Mr. Davis' goal was accomplished in 2001 with four round trips daily between Portland and Boston with seven stops. The trip now takes 2 hours and 25 minutes each way and will accommodate almost 500,000 riders this year. Train Riders Northeast acts as volunteer host on the train as well as an advocacy group to extend service to Brunswick and Lewiston/Auburn. Thank you to Dan Davidson for inviting Wayne to speak to us tonight.
