Program - Tonight's speaker was Elizabeth McClellan, President and Founder of Partners For World Health (PWH). PWH has the mission of inspiring connections to care for people and preserve our planet. Elizabeth, who is a Nursing Administrator at Maine Medical Center, was aware of the large amount of discarded medical supplies that is mandated by CDC. By collecting, sorting and distributing these supplies throughout the world, PWH is reaching out to these third world countries that otherwise might not have the opportunity to use these valuable supplies. The operation utilizes a warehouse on Marginal Way (the old AAA building - thank you, Tom Kinley) for the sorting process. The medical facilities that donate these supplies are happy because it lowers their cost of disposal. So far, over 10,000 lbs of medical supplies have been distributed to over 36 different locations. Thank you to Diane York for inviting Elizabeth to speak to us tonight.
