Sustainable Landscape Architecture — Our speaker this week was our own Catherine Callahan of Callahan + Lebleu ("Lebleu" is Catherine's husband Bret). Catherine has a master's degree in landscape architecture from Cornell, specializing in sustainable landscapes. Much of what sustainable landscape architecture involves is making disturbed sites more ecologically friendly by using native plants, eliminating the use of chemicals and providing habitat. One of the most common "disturbed sites" is the typical homeowner's yard. Striking facts about this are that homeowners use more chemicals than farmers, and mowing the lawn for one hour typically uses as much fuel as driving a car for 5 hours.

One of the quickly growing trends is for green roofs – on a hot summer day a typical roof can be 90 degrees hotter than the air, but a green roof is actually a few degrees cooler. Catherine closed with these guidelines for improving sustainability:

- 1. Reduce lawn.
- 2. Use organic lawn care practices
- 3. Choose plants for site conditions
- 4. Choose native plants
- 5. Care for soil organically (e.g. bark mulch rather than fertilizer)
- 6. Create habitat
- 7. Use sustainable materials
- 8. Save the Rain reduce run-off
- 9. Decrease impervious surfaces
- 10. Increase pervious surfaces (plants are best)

<u>Children's Garden Update</u> – In the Q&A at the end of Catherine's talk, Catherine (who is on the Fort Williams Arboretum Committee) indicated that the Children's Garden is in the design phase, and construction is expected to start in 2014.
