This recognition comes with a certificate and a pin. Also, an individual or club can donate \$1,000 and request that someone else be recognized as a Paul Harris Fellow (PHF). After someone is a PHF, additional contributions of \$1,000 result in that person being a PHF+1, +2, etc. Our club had already recognized Peter's prior contributions of service to our club by making him a PHF. Since his tireless efforts during the tree sale (he was most certainly there more than any club member!) cried out for recognition (and maybe because we have no imagination?) we made him a Paul Harris Fellow again... in other words a Paul Harris Fellow+1.
