2014-15 Inaugural Meeting – Kathy Cotter led her first meeting as president as we visited the Boys & Girls Club in South Portland. (See below for the rest of our new Board – congratulations to all and thanks for your service to the club!) Our club has a long history with the Boys & Girls Club (thank you Dan Mooers for researching it!), beginning with a fundraiser in 1971 to help build the SP club. The fundraiser, the Water Follies, was apparently aptly named. Despite its lack of success, however, the club eventually donated \$10,000 towards construction of the club.
