Partners in Development Inc – This is the background to the following story about Kaylene’s trip to Guatemala. Partners in Development (PID) was founded in 1990 by a couple from Ipswich, Mass. It started as a child sponsorship program for children in Haiti and Guatemala. Over the years as they have seen the needs of the families they have been helping, they have expanded to add a

- Small Business Loan Program
- Housing Program, and
- Medical Program

PID hosts work trips to Haiti and Guatemala throughout the year. Which bring us to our program:

Kaylene Learns to Build a House – or maybe just to how to dig a hole? Kaylene accompanied students from the SMCC Rotaract club, along with some Kennebunk club Rotarians, on a PID work trip to a village in Guatemala where they helped construct houses and also built and installed water filtration units. While there Kaylene realized that training materials and a testing

program were needed for the water filtration units so she will be following up on that before her next trip (she plans to take SMCC students there annually). Our club donated \$500 towards Kaylene's trip expenses and she donated the funds to PID's emergency children's fund. Of course if you're reading this but weren't at the meeting, you missed out on seeing all of her pictures of adorable children who clearly captured Kaylene's heart, most especially Lorena, the little girl whom Kaylene is sponsoring.
