He has a gentleman's agreement arrangement with Nate Maxwell to farm on the Maxwell land, thus ensuring that the land does not become developed. Nick's love of farming began at age 13 as a 4-H'er when he raised a pig in his backyard. He moved on to cows and other animals while still in his teens, borrowing other people's land to raise them on. Nick's is a remarkable story of persistence and passion for farming – we wish him much success.
