More About the Bulgaria Trip:

When is it? Probably late March/early April for 2 weeks.

Where is Bulgaria? North of Greece and Turkey, south of Romania and west of the Black Sea.

Who's paying for it? The airfare and some travel costs will be covered by a travel allowance of \$1,500 per team member provided by Rotary Foundation funds. Costs while in Bulgaria will be minimal since they will be hosted by Rotarians of District 2482.

What is the capital of Bulgaria? Sofia, the largest city.

What's the point of the trip? To further the Rotary Foundation's goal of world understanding. Specifically the team members will be soaking up the culture of Bulgaria, including folk music which the Bulgarians are known for, and if they're lucky visiting some of the 9 historical and natural objects designated as UNESCO World Heritage sites. Perhaps they will even get to see "Nestinarstvo," a ritual fire-dance included in the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage.

Will there by parties? Until 1989, Bulgaria was the world's second-largest wine exporter, so I'm guessing yes.
