Club Program – The July 9 speaker was James Willey, president of the Board of Directors of the Friends of Long Creek Youth Development Center. The mission of the Friends is to support programs directed toward returning youth in the Maine criminal justice system to their communities as productive citizens. They do this in several ways. The Friends are a network of over 200 volunteers that do one-on-one mentoring with the inmates. They also provide amenities such as uniforms for the sports teams, reduced cost college courses at SMCC, clothing when necessary, and continue to follow up with the inmates after they have been released. The Maine Youth Center has overcome its negative past and the Long Creek Youth Center is now a national leader in youth corrections.
