<u>Working with the "Kids with Funny Suits On"</u> – This is how new member Steve Klemm describes the 117 chimpanzees at the Jane Goodall Institute where he worked for three months in 2005. Steve started a non-profit in Bali called the "Great Ape Protection Program" in Bali, which he ran for 10 years. Steve painted a bleak picture for these animals, whom he predicts will cease to exist in the wild in about 10-15 years due to deforestation. The sanctuary employed 40 armed guards to protect the chimps from poachers. Steve got the idea of providing additional protection

through aerial photography. This interest in aerial photography eventually led to his current profession of aerial photography using drones, which he streams to the internet.

Steve also spoke about the Rotary Club in Bali where he was a member for 12 years and said that "it was an honor to be part of it."
