Not only did we give generously to the Annual Fund, but we also gave \$6,821.87 towards the eradication of polio. In other good news, our District has also exceeded its goal of \$173,179 and as a District we have donated \$174,677.14 to PolioPlus (including a single \$100,000 bequest).
