## New Club Boosts Access to Water in Uganda

Despite three years of economic growth, Entebbe, Uganda, is still mired in high poverty rates, inadequate health care, and water insecurity. Michael Muriithi connected with friends in the Rotary Club of Entebbe to establish a new club to address concerns in one of the city's largest communities, Nkumba. The Rotary Club of Nkumba has 40 members whose average age is 35. The club raised more than \$2,000 to dig and construct a new latrine pit for the Kitala Health Centre after the old one was closed due to unsanitary conditions. They also constructed latrines and renovated a major water well, increasing clean water availability by 40 percent, with plans to install four more wells by the end of the year.
