<u>Say It With Flowers</u> – our speaker was Dan Kennedy, owner of the DLK Floral Group, which consists of Harmons Bartons, Sawyer & Company and Minott's Flowers, and is the largest florist

in Maine. Dan started out at the age of 14 deadheading flowers in a greenhouse in "the County." He opened his first flower shop at 18 and opened a second store at age 21. In 1990 he moved to the big city (Portland) to work for Harmons Bartons, which he later purchased in 2007. The number of florists has decreased dramatically in this country due to the influence of the internet and the big box stores. Dan stressed that satisfaction is always guaranteed at his business, and that's the difference between buying local and ordering flowers over the internet. In addition every floral arrangement his shops produce is custom-made; every bouquet is beautiful, no matter what the price.
