<u>Raking for Frank</u> – Ellie Speh reports that Frank is continuing to mend and is able to go up and down stairs now. There will be a leaf-raking party from 9-11 on Saturday, October 26, preceded by optional breakfast at Uncle Andy's at 8 a.m. Several people have signed up already and there will be a couple leaf blowers available so the job should go quickly.

<u>Changes at the Soup Kitchen</u> – With cold weather coming, some of the diners at the Soup Kitchen may face the choice of getting a hot meal or a warm bed. Why? Because on some nights in order to get a bed at the homeless shelter, you have to be in line by 6:00. And once you get your bed, you're not allowed to leave for dinner and then come back. In order to prevent people from having to make this no-win choice, the Soup Kitchen will be experimenting with new hours. Effective November 1, the soup kitchen will be open for customers from 4:30 to 6:00 and for volunteers from 3:30 to 6:30.

In addition, the soup kitchen management finds that it is disruptive to have volunteers come and go in the middle of dinner, so they are requesting that all volunteer groups commit to providing volunteers who will work the entire shift. We are being asked to provide 12 volunteers for the full shift each month; if we are not able to accommodate this, we will be paired with another volunteer group.

<u>Africa Mercy</u> – Our regularly scheduled speaker was forced to cancel due to illness, but like the Boy Scouts, Bill York is always prepared. The backup program was a segment from "60 Minutes" about the Mercy Ships, and in particular the Africa Mercy, which was filmed in Togo, where several people with disfiguring – and potentially lethal – benign facial tumors received surgical treatment that allowed them to live normal lives again. The piece was very moving and made us feel good that Rotary Foundation dollars (and even donations from SPCE Rotary) have helped to support this program.
