<u>All Aboard!</u> – Our speaker this week was Natalie Bogart, Marketing Director for the Northern New England Passenger Rail Authority (NNEPRA). The NNEPRA is a state agency that contracts with Amtrak to provide rail service on the Downeaster. The Downeaster runs 5 round trips to Boston daily from Brunswick and Portland. Since it shares the track with freight trains, Amtrak is limited in the number and timing of Downeaster trips. There were 438,364 passengers on the Downeaster in the past fiscal year, and over 5.4 million passengers since 2001. Passengers on the Downeaster have given it the highest satisfaction ratings in the Amtrak system.
