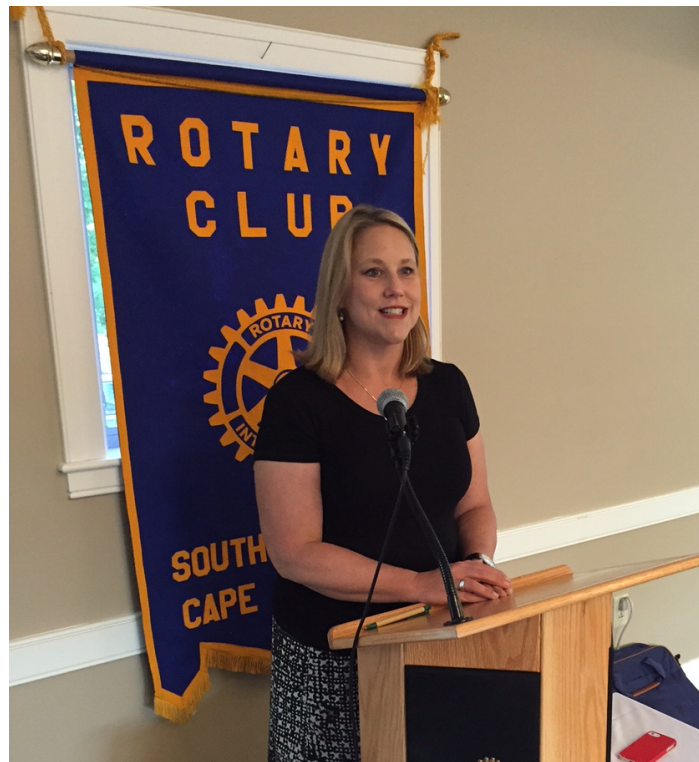

Jennifer Rooks Calling – Our speaker this evening was a familiar voice to everyone, MPBN’s host of Maine Calling, Jennifer Rooks. Jennifer described the course of her career in broadcasting, starting out as a go-fer for a TV station in San Francisco. At the onset of the big 1989 earthquake, her boss told everyone to call various parts of the state so they could determine where the epicenter was. By chance the area he assigned Jennifer to call turned out to be the source of the most damage and reporters were dispatched as soon as she reported her findings. Realizing that so much of the city depended on the information being broadcast by her colleagues confirmed for her that broadcasting should be her chosen career. She moved to Maine in 1994 to work at Channel 6 and then later became the host of MPBN’s MaineWatch. When budget cuts forced the closure of the TV production department, she transferred from television to her current radio position. Jennifer said that one of the challenges of the show is finding interesting topics – something that would be of interest to everyone in their statewide audience.
