<u>Hola - Come Meet the Argentinians!</u> – The Vocational Training Team from Argentina made up of mental health professionals is now in our District, and will be staying with the LoBoscos and AnaMaria on Sunday and Monday nights. All are invited to stop by the LoBoscos at around 7:30 either evening to meet the team. We will gather around John's fire pit if the weather is nice, but this is a rain or shine event and will move indoors if necessary. John's house is at 21 Fessenden Road in Cape Elizabeth – hope to see you there!

<u>Hearing, Hands & H2O</u> – Portland Rotarians Roger & Elizabeth Fagan, and Dick Giles visited us this week to describe the "3-H" projects that the Portland club has been carrying out in the Dominican Republic for several years. Our club has donated \$1,000 to the project this year, as well as last year. Additional funding has come from The Rotary Foundation – they have received 6 major Matching Grants as well as a global grant so far.

- Hearing the Fagans take used hearing aids to the Dominican Republic to fit children at the school for the deaf. Recently they have been able to provide them with solar powered battery chargers so that the children will be able to get continuous use out of their hearing aids for at least 3 years.
- Hands this project has been spearheaded by Portland Rotarian John Curran. An exciting development this year is that they will be providing hands produced by 3-D printers. Measurements were taken on their last trip to the DR and when they return in the fall they will be able to bring the customized hands with them.
- Water Dick Giles described how he was somewhat reluctantly lured into heading up this project and how worthwhile it has been. This year they have installed 100 sand water filters, which will provide clean water for about 700 people.

These projects are "hands on" projects – volunteers are always welcomed. Let Scott know if you have an interest in participating in one of their trips to the Dominican Republic.
