"America's Craft Beer Capital" – Where is it? Right here! Portland has more breweries per capita than any other city in the US! This fact and many many more were presented to us by Sean Sullivan, Executive Director of the Maine Brewer's Guild. The Guild's mission is to promote and protect the craft beer industry. Craft beer is the fastest growing industry in the state, and a bigger industry than lobster based on sales revenues. Craft beer represents quality over quantity, and craft brewing is "manufacturing with a face." In the US as a whole only about 15% of beer consumption is from craft brewers, but in Maine that figure is 25% - we believe in buying local! Another aspect of beer production that favors Maine is that our soil is suitable for growing the two main crops that go into beer production – hops and barley.
