Speaking of Veterans – Dan Davidson relayed an update he received from the VA. From 2014 to 2015 there was a 46% decrease in the number of homeless veterans in Maine. Sixty percent of the homeless veterans in Maine live in Cumberland County so the problem is definitely right in our own backyard. We'd like to think that our donations of pots & pans, bedding, etc. that help veterans get established when they move into their own apartments contributes to the success the VA is having.

If You Can Read This... – Obviously you can, and aren't you fortunate that you can! One of our District Governor Marge's passions is promoting literacy and the District will be presenting Literacy Awards to all qualifying clubs at the end of the year. President Bill sent out a brochure outlining the criteria and is asking for suggestions on projects that our club might be interested in. As a reminder here are some of the things that we already do that will count toward this award:

- Devote a club meeting to creating awareness of literacy project opportunities (we did that last night!)
- Donate books to a local school, library, or food pantry (as described above, we donate books to both of our local community libraries)
- Award one or more scholarships to a student (we award scholarships to students at both local high schools and have plans to award scholarships at SMCC)
- Sponsor an Early Act Club, an Interact Club, or a Rotaract Club (we sponsor an Interact club at both high schools)
- □ Sponsor one or more youth to attend an educational event such as RYLA we send numerous students to RYLA every year

In the Rotary year just ended we also supported programs in the schools such as Peace Jam and Hassle to Tassel, sponsored several camperships for elementary students, and paid tuition for a remedial program for an ESL student. I didn't write down all the suggestions that folks had last night (but Bill did) – if you have any ideas for ways that you would like to see us expand our efforts with education and literacy, please let Bill know.
