<u>Sea Cadets</u> – We were joined this week by Petty Officer Lucas Wright, a sophomore at Scarborough HS who would like to attend the Naval Academy or the Coast Guard Academy. He was accompanied by the local Sea Cadets Commanding Officer Shannen Williamsen and Senior Chief John Hart, retired from the Coast Guard Reserve. Tony introduced them and misplaced his notes – they are now in my possession and I was interested to learn that Shannen joined the Sea Cadets as an adult leader at the same time that his daughter joined the Sea Cadets. He now has two daughters in the unit.

The Sea Cadets are a national military-based youth leadership group, supported at the national level by the US government but at the local level by the students themselves and fundraisers. Our club had the privilege to outfit their Color Guard with flags, harnesses and a banner, so that they can march proudly in parades such as the recent Veterans' Day parade in South Portland.
