A Wonderful Italian Meal – We ventured out of Purpoodock this week and had a delicious Italian dinner. Thank you to:

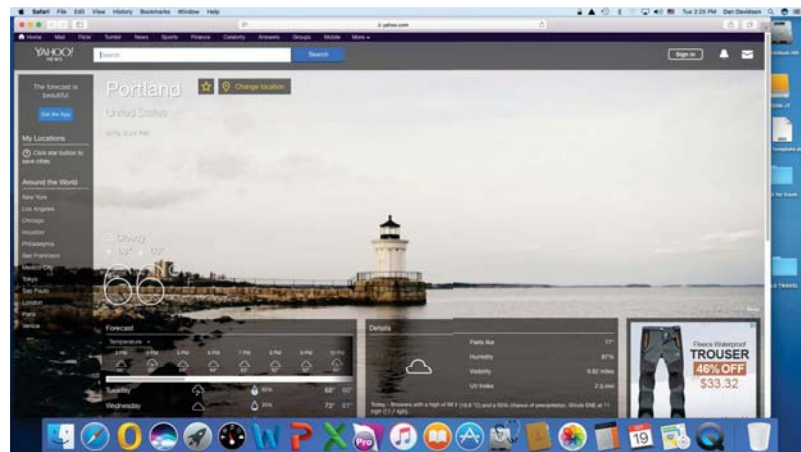
