Our speakers were WK Executive Director Julie Mulkern and Special Events & Sponsorship Manager Mary-Theresa Tringale. Winter Kids began as a learn-to-ski program in 1997 and has grown to be much more, primarily offering services through the schools. They now serve over 12,000 school children in Maine through curriculum programs with an outdoor component.
