<u>SPHS Interact Has Been Busy</u> – And we know that because the Locker Project's April newsletter had this story about them:




South Portland High

Twice a month, **Courtney** loads up the van and heads to South Portland High School for a fresh food event, and recently, a student group called the Interact Club has joined her. Club members have been helping to unload produce from the van, chatting with Courtney and with their peers about the fresh food available, and creating recipes for students and staff.

"Club members stop by the table throughout my time there to see if I need help and restock the table. These events are a great opportunity for kids to try things they have wanted to try or never thought to try--at no cost. One time I had pomegranates and they were a huge hit! I really enjoy getting to know the kids and witnessing how kind they are, sharing food with each other and the larger community."
