<u>Sustainability</u> – Our speaker this week was Steve Genovese, the Greater Portland Council of Governments Resilience Corps Fellow with the South Portland Sustainability Office. Steve served with the Peace Corps in Tanzania from 2018 to 2020 and upon his return started working on a master's degree in Energy and Environmental Planning and Management from UConn, which he is getting close to completing. Steve spoke about 5 focus areas of the Sustainability Office:

- Buildings & Energy Use
- Transportation & Land Use
- Waste Reduction
- Climate Resilience
- Community Engagement

These areas are components of the One Climate Future plan, which is a joint plan between South Portland and Portland. Since Steve is a GPCOG Fellow, much of his work involves coordinating with Cape Elizabeth and Scarborough also. Steve gave us lots of interesting facts and I'm not sure if I wrote them down correctly so I won't repeat them – but needless to say we learned a lot and the audience was very curious and engaged.
