<u>Guests</u> – We were joined by Kennebunk Chief of Police/District Governor-Elect Bob MacKenzie. Club members joining in person included Patty Sprague and Aaron Filieo (2 weeks in a row!!) We were also joined again by our most recent members Pamela Fox and Kevin Williams – here's the photo that Scott took of Pamela being welcomed into the club, which I didn't have at the time that I wrote about her induction.



<u>Policing in Today's World</u> – Chris introduced our speaker Paul Fenton, Chief of Police for the town of Cape Elizabeth. Paul joined the CE police force in 1997 and rose through the ranks, becoming chief in 2018. He is a graduate of Brandeis and Husson and has a score of accreditations/certifications to his name.

Chief Fenton spoke about the challenges of recruiting and retaining talented officers. He said that he hires for character and trains for the rest. The training includes monthly in-house trainings; he believes these in-person events help the department to build a culture of collegiality. When asked about the biggest challenge facing the department, he said that mental health calls are "through the roof." He spoke highly of the department's relationship with the departments of the neighboring communities of South Portland and Scarborough, who all share a common dispatch center.

Our recent speaker town manager Matt Sturgis spoke glowingly of Chief Fenton and and this presentation gave us an appreciation for why he has such a high opinion of the chief.
