Thanks for playing, and making it fun!!!



Other points of information:

- Everything you need to know will be in a 3-ring binder inside the trailer.
- Please remember to replace the key to the padlock on the trailer as soon as you open the lock.
- If you have tree sale expenses, there is a reimbursement form at the bottom of the "Members Only" dropdown on the club website.
- We have an abundant supply of tree stands these all came from the swap show so our cost is zero. There is no set price for these so please ask customers for a donation (and enter it as a donation rather than a sale).
- There are 2 ipads for recording sales; each has a battery pack if needed (keep it in your pocket to keep it warm).

- Please wear Rotary gear if you don't have a Rotary winter hat (which are nice and warm) please wear an apron.
