<u>CONGRATULATIONS!</u> - to several businesses who received awards last week from the City of South Portland. Most notably, our own Catherine Dorrington whose business, Coastal Care Solutions, was recognized as the Small Business of the Year. In her acceptance speech she mentioned Rotary and thanked her dad – also a Rotarian – who was in attendance.

The CEO and staff of Boys and Girls Club Southern Maine were given special recognition for 50 years in South Portland. Tony Wagner made introductory remarks for the presentation, in which he mentioned the formation of the South Portland clubhouse and Rotary's role in its founding.

Also recognized were the Soucy family (owners of Port Harbor Marine) who were Business Leaders of the Year. Rob mentioned Rotary as the primary organization that they sponsor. Another of our sponsors, Broadway Bowl, was recognized as New Business of the Year.

<u>Recovery Basics</u> – Our speaker on Wednesday was Carolyn Delaney, founder and CEO of Journey Enterprises, the publisher of the magazine that informs readers about the issues around recovery. She was very upfront in telling us that she has been sober since 1993. She was excited to tell us about a brand new online course available on the Journey website called "Recovery Basics." This 45-minute course, which can be accessed without providing your personal information, is designed to educate the masses about recovery. She shared facts with us such as:


- ✓ There are 26 million people in recovery in this country (although that may be a low estimate)
- \checkmark 40 million people struggle with addiction
- \checkmark 75% of addicts are employed
- \checkmark 1 in 3 people are affected by someone else's addiction
- \checkmark Addiction occurs due to processes within the brain beyond the person's control
- \checkmark 46% of addicts stop using without any formal outside support

This was a very interesting and informative program, of which we have many many during Chris Speh's tenure as program chair. Many of the ideas come from club members so please keep feeding him those ideas. And Chris believes in succession planning so please consider becoming his apprentice so that you could perhaps take over the reins from him sometime. It's a very interesting and rewarding "job" in the club and he'd love to talk to you about it. <u>SpringFest Update</u> – Bev reported that the sponsorships have reached over \$41,000 with some sponsorships still in the works. If you have any suggestions for a business they should approach, please let Bev, Tony or Adrienne know.
